9 Hole Par 3 Short Course

As a privilege card holder you have unlimited access to play the 9-hole Par 3 short course for free. Please note that from time to time the Par 3 course will be closed to golfers to allow Footgolf to be played. During the week the course will also be shared by golfers and footgolfers in the afternoon. Please visit www.chichestergolf.com for updates and timings.

Two Championship 18-hole Courses

Choose to play the Tower or Cathedral course at Chichester Golf Club and receive a 20% discount off the standard green fee including morning rates and twilight rate. Not valid to play at our sister courses at Hill Barn Golf Club or Horton Park Golf Club.

Please note Privilege card holders and visitors are not permitted to play the Cathedral course before 9am during the week and before 10am at the weekend.

Booking a Tee Time

As a Privilege Card Holder you are able to book tee times up to 13 days in advance and all tee times must be booked either online <https://www.e-s-p.com/elitelive/login.php> or via the EliteLive App. We cannot accept bookings either in person or over the telephone.

How to book online or via the 'EliteLive' App

To make a booking please provide us with your email address so that we can send you a verification code and link that you will need to follow when you register as a member for the first time via the online booking system or the 'EliteLive' App.

Please note that if you have registered as a 'Visitor' before then please enter the same log in details when prompted.

The booking app is the easiest and most simplest way to book a tee time and to manage your account. By using the app you can book & cancel tee times, view & top up your levy balance and receive notifications direct from the club.

You can download the App via the App Store and search 'EliteLive' or from the Google Play Store.

How to cancel a Tee Time

If you are unable to play you must cancel your booking online or via the App by selecting the option 'view booking history'.

Pace of Play Guidelines

Pace of play is very important to us here at Chichester Golf Club, We ask all golfers to be aware of their timings, keep up with the game in front and let faster groups through.

We recommend the following timings for a four ball on each course:

Cathedral Course

Front nine No more than 2 hours 20 minutes
Back nine No more than 2 hours

Tower Course

Holes 1-11 No more than 2 hours 15 minutes
Holes 12-18 No more than 1 hour 45 minutes

Driving Range

The Driving Range has undergone a major refurbishment with significant investment and features the first ever **TrackMan** in England! TrackMan technology allows players to work on areas they need to, showcasing crucial data from the ball's measurements - making it a powerful practice tool. Whether you're playing alone or with friends, the new TrackMan technology can improve your skills and have fun!

The driving range itself is floodlit and has an extensive collection of colourful 10 metre wide targets and Power Tees are also available on many of the inside bays. There is also a practice bunker and the outside bays include a Huxley Golf mat which gives the feel of natural grass.

We use only best quality Srixon one piece range balls which are dispensed from a range ball machine.

You do not need to book to play on the Driving Range, just turn up with your own clubs and buy a basket of balls or a get up to 25% extra range credit with a range card which can be added to your privilege swipe card.

Footgolf

Footgolf is open to all and operates on the Par 3 course along with standard golf – please see website for timings. The cost to play Footgolf will be charged at just £5 for privilege cardholders.

Adventure Golf

The 18-hole indoor & outdoor adventure golf courses are fun for all ages and both courses are open daily from 9am (excluding 25 Dec). The cost to play is £10 per adult and £7 per child. Family and group rates are also available. Please see website for more information.

Exclusive Discounts for Privilege Card Holders in the Clubhouse and Shops

Privilege card holders can obtain a 5% discount on food and drink purchases and on retail items (exclusions apply) from the shops. To take advantage of the discount you need to add a 'levy' to your account. The minimum amount you can add is £20.00. You can top up your levy at any time either online or via the app. Please note that any levy added to your account is non-refundable and can only be used when your account is up to date.

Services

Over both golf courses we have buggies, electric trolleys, pull trolleys and rental clubs available to hire from the Pro Shop. Buggies are always in high demand and we recommend that all buggies are booked in advance when you book a tee time, either online or via the app. You must be 17 years and over.

A refreshments buggy is available on both courses at the weekend and on week days in the summer.

We can also offer you advice on your golf equipment (re-gripping, club adjustments, custom fitting, replacing spikes etc). Should you require any of these services please enquire in the pro shop.

Renewal

We will write to you one month in advance of your renewal date and invite you to renew your Privilege card for another year. Please let us know if you do not wish to renew your card so that we do not contact you unnecessarily.

Cancellation

A privilege card cannot be cancelled for any reason (including medical or otherwise) and any unused months are non-refundable.

Membership

If you would like to become a member at Chichester Golf Club then you can do this at any time and you will not have to pay a joining fee. We will convert any unused months of your Privilege Card into a cash value and discount this amount from the new membership subscription fee. Please ask a member of staff for more information on how to do this.
